The Department understands that National Grid intends to file a petition with the New York State Public Service Commission (PSC) for cost recovery as related to Vaporizers 13 and 14 pursuant to a process established under the PSC's "Order Approving Joint Proposal, as Modified, and Imposing Additional Requirements," issued on August 12, 2021 in Case 19-G-0309 *et al.*, that includes both evaluation of the project by an independent consultant and an opportunity for public comment. The Department understands that the Order (at p. 121) requires National Grid to make a showing that Vaporizers 13 and 14 are, among other things, "demonstrably needed for reliability purposes." Order at p. 121. To ensure the Department has all the necessary facts and information to make an informed decision on the pending permit application, it is appropriate to extend the suspension of the time frames in 6 NYCRR § 621.10 for the Department to make a final permit decision on this application until thirty (30) days after the PSC issues a decision on the petition.
